- Support teachers through staff development

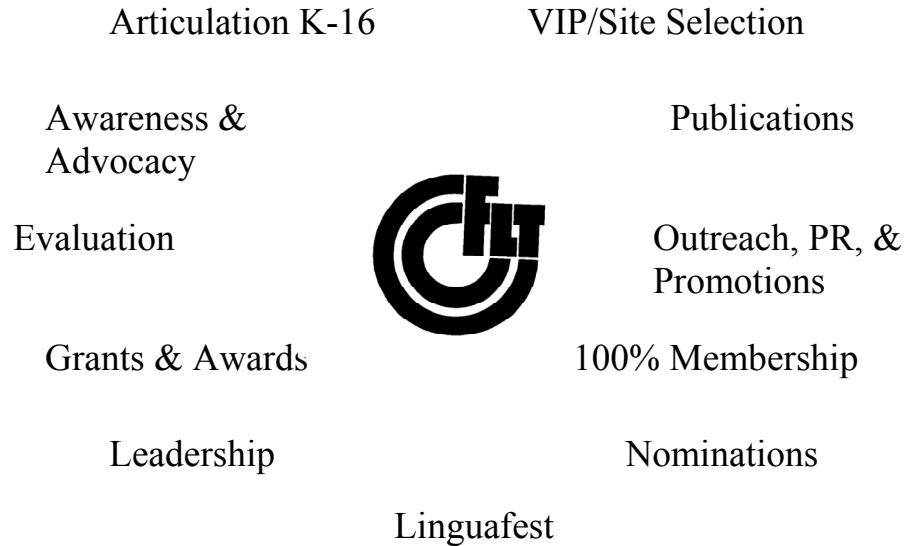
Does CCFLT?
